

SACRAMENT PREPARATION REQUIREMENTS 2010-2011

If you would like to apply for your child to receive the sacraments of Reconciliation and/or Eucharist, please register your child for Religious Education classes
In order to be eligible,

- ❖ your child must be a baptized Catholic in grade 3 (or older)
- ❖ the Religious Education department must have proof of **Catholic** Baptism



if baptized at Epiphany: fill out necessary information on application

if baptized elsewhere: obtain a copy of the Catholic Baptismal Certificate and include with the application for sacrament preparation classes. If you do not have the certificate, please contact the baptismal church and request a copy. If you have difficulty locating an address or phone number, please ask us for assistance

- ❖ the minimum formation requirements are the following: completion of grade 2 and current registration for grade 3 in a weekly parish Religious Education program or Community Faith Formation - or Catholic school
- ❖ the program consists of Sunday afternoon classes which must be attended by at least one parent/guardian AND child. Weekly attendance at Religious Education classes or Community Faith Formation continue to be required.

SPECIAL SACRAMENT NEEDS (RCIC):

- ❖ students from Grade 2 and above who have not been baptized Catholic or have special sacramental needs must attend weekly Religious Education classes or the Community Faith Formation Program and apply to the RCIC program—for special Sacraments.
