POSITION	DESCRIPTION
TEACHER (Elementary)	Prepares for class and teacher lesson every week; assisted by aide or co-teacher and supported by teacher training, resources, lesson plans and staff
CO-TEACHER (Elementary)	Shares in preparation and teaching duties; BOTH teacher and co-teacher attend class each week; supported by teacher training, resources, lesson plans and staff
AIDE (Elementary)	Assists teacher in classroom and attends each class; supported by teacher training, resources, lesson plans and staff
CATECHIST TEAM (Middle School/High School)	Works in group to plan lessons and facilitate program sessions; training and support ongoing
SUBSTITUTE (Elementary, Middle/High School)	Fills in for teacher or aide with little notice
PROGRAM MONITOR (Elementary)	Helps supervise arrival and dismissal of students; assists in emergencies; assists staff and teachers during program
HOSPITALITY TEAM (Middle/High School)	Assists with program needs
CONFIRMATION SPONSOR	Shares faith with a candidate for Confirmation; attends Confirmation classes January-April; participates in Sacrament of Confirmation
CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD -Team Leader -Discussion Leader	<i>Training sessions and materials provided:</i> - leads Liturgy of the Word for children - leads small group discussion and activity
OUTREACH IN LOVE	Works with youth or young adults with mental retardation weekly from October – May (Wednesday 7:00-8:30 PM or Sunday 10-11 AM)
